

MONSON CLUB AGE VERIFICATION POLICY

Premises Age Verification Policy, Monson Club Ltd, Lyndale Road, Redhill, Surrey. RH1 2HA

- 1). This policy applies in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol on these premises.
- 2). For this policy the responsible person is one of the following:
 - A member of the Management Team present on the Club premises in a capacity which enables him or her to prevent the supply in question.
 - A person aged 18 or over who is authorised to allow the sale or supply of alcohol.
- 3). Staff serving alcohol on the premises must require any individuals who appear to be under the age of 18 years of age to produce on request (to the responsible person), before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark. In this section "Staff" also includes any member of the management team serving behind the bar.
- 4). Examples of appropriate identification include:
 - A passport
 - A photo card driving licence
 - A proof of age bearing the PASS hologram
 - A military Identification Card.
 - A Government Identification Card.
- 5). The Management Team will ensure that Staff are made aware of the existence and content of this policy.
- 6). This policy does not exclude best practise schemes such as Challenge 21 or Challenge 25 which requires individuals who appear to be under an age which is greater than 18 to provide identification.
- 7). The Management Committee has the overall responsibility for implementing the Policy and the planning, organisation, control, monitoring and review of this policy.
